Recommended actions to reduce the end of the year deficit

(S-1)

It is recommended that the following cost reduction actions be implemented effective January 4, 2010:

- All bus stops will be combined into cluster stops.

Note: According to Ohio Law, students may be required to walk up to ½ mile to a designated pick-up and drop-off area bus stop. It is recommended that parents form neighborhood groups in order to monitor students walking to a bus pick-up, drop-off area. The district will save over \$70,000 for the remainder of the year by changing to cluster bus stops.

- Pay to Participate Fees will be as follows for the 2009-2010 school year:

CHS & CJHS Winter sports	-	\$150.00
Erwine Winter sports	-	\$100.00
CHS & CJHS Spring sports	-	\$150.00
Erwine Spring sports	-	\$100.00
All Cheerleaders	-	\$ 50.00

Note: Payment for winter sports will be due January 15, 2010.

- Lunch prices will be increased to the following rates:

Elementary from \$2.25 to \$2.75
Secondary from \$2.50 to \$3.00
Milk price will increase from \$.45 to \$.50

- All school buildings not hosting a school athletic, choir or band event will be closed at 4:00 p.m. Non-school groups or organizations wishing to use buildings after 4:00 p.m. will be charged as follows:

Youth Sports teams \$10.00/hour
Outside groups or organizations \$25.00/hour
Weekends – same hourly rental fee plus custodial and/or cook wages.

Note: The Summit Choral Society will not be charged additional fees beyond their current contract for the remainder of the current school year.

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- Students participating in extra-curricular clubs will be charged a fee based on the number of students in that club needed to cover the advisor's supplemental contract costs, not to exceed \$25.00 per student.

Note: This fee is being determined by the building principal and the school treasurer and will be shared with the students upon their return in January.

- The number of district newsletters published in the Suburbanite will be reduced from three to two per year.
- Contracts days for the following classified positions will be reduced as follows:

Communication Information Specialist – from 184 work days + 8 paid holidays
to 178 work days + 8 paid holidays

Classroom Assistant – from 181 work days + 8 paid holidays to 178 work days + 8 paid holidays

Accounting Assistant (Treasurer's Office) – from full-time to 225 work days + 10 paid holidays
from 40 hrs/week to 32 hrs/week

- Purchased Services Elementary Technology position will be reduced from four days a week to three days a week.
- All field trips, unless paid for with non-general funds, or those required by a student IEP, will be eliminated for the remainder of the school year.
- Effective January 1, 2010, the monthly fee for members of the Portage Lakes Fitness Center will be increased by \$3.00 per member.
- Suspension of athletic uniform purchases from general fund.
